There are ten parts depots and ten regional offices offering extensive service and marketing support worldwide. The company has companies situated in Russia, Europe, Brazil, Singapore, Dubai, Poland, India, South Africa, Australia and the USA. Dresssta's Precision Machines The company's success is based on manufacturing a variety of machines that undergo rigorous testing to meet specific high standards while offering excellent technical support and competitively priced equipment. The company has many units available including pipelayers, crawler loaders, crawl dozers and belt shifters. Efficient Cummins engines power the Dresssta dozers to meet EU emissions. To minimize overheating issues, a Direct Drive powertrain is available for humid working environments. The cabins provide efficient air conditioning and heating systems and panoramic vision to ensure complete operator comfort during dusty and hot applications. Cabs are sealed to suppress sound and allow the operators to work at optimum performance levels. Hydraulic systems are designed to put the operator in control with precise joystick engineering for predictable and precise positioning of the clamp during combined, parallel and radial shifting operations. Equipment Customization The Dresssta line has customizable features with a particular engineering team to create efficient designs, modifications and attachment performance for a variety of applications. There are many special feature packages offered for different models. Arctic Package One of the popular Special Feature Requests for Dresssta machines is the Arctic Package that allows the machine to work at maximum capacity during colder climate applications. Some of the popular Arctic Package items include reinforced blades, push arms for dozers, ripper shanks, extra lighting for blizzard visibility, steering levers that can handle thicker gloves, fuel heating, arctic cabs, oil heaters, a pre-heating system for the engine and cab heating. Application Customization Stockpile The stockpile compaction feature package has been created for Dresssta's crawler dozer series to manage job situations that include sloped locations that are often unstable. The Dresssta SFR equipment features a heavy-duty steel drum complete with a winch line attachment and brackets connected to the drum. The line is prevented from touching the slope face thanks to the tensioning system. A precision line guide and cleaning system are in place. Fire Tractor Dozers This line of fire tractor dozers is perfect for containing, preventing and cleaning up after forest fires. These dozers are working around falling trees, heavy ash, dirt, airborne sand and burning sap. The fire crews rely on the dozers to remove combustible material, cut path and clear fire lines. There is fire suppression available made with an onboard control unit, nozzles and external sensors. A forestry cab kit helps to protect the operator and the machine with guards, steel mesh screens, sweeps and metallic fire curtains to eliminate damage from trees that fall during the fire. The electrical components inside the tractor are protected by fire-resistant sheeting, while heavy-duty guards protect hoses and hydraulic cylinders. Fire plows, bush blades and winches are some of the other pieces of equipment used to combat fires. Special features are implemented to prevent overheating such as cooling modules for the powertrain, charge air and radiator and the direct drive

powertrain. Belt Shifting Conveyor belts are used by mining applications to transport debris and minerals from the seam where they are found to different locations for reprocessing. The Dressta SB-85 is helpful for rapid repositioning of conveyor belts and realignment. This machine is commonly used in confined spaces and can be used to shift railway tracks. It features high ground clearance making it useful for difficult terrain and features a 2500mm belt width.
